**Ms A M M Weber (DA) to ask the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment:**

- (1) Whether, with reference to her reply to question 2359 of 30 October 2020, wherein she advises that SA National Parks (SANParks) does not recommend hunting offtakes to the private community and state-managed reserves open to the Kruger National Park, but rather comment and support the hunting offtakes, she will furnish Ms A M M Weber with the (a) letter in which SANParks advised that it had studied and supported the requested Associated Private Nature Reserves (APNR) animal offtakes and (b) copy of the letter and addenda referred to (details furnished); if not, why not; if so, on what date;
- (2) whether she will furnish Ms A M M Weber with the minutes of the meetings wherein SANParks studied the APNR request; if not, why not; if so, on what date?

**3094. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:**

- 1) (a) The letter requested is attached as **Annexure A**.
- (b) Attached for ease of reference, please find **Annexure B**, Addendum 2, referred to in the aforementioned document. SANParks is not at liberty to release the Associated Private Nature Reserve (APNR) off-take request (Addendum 1 referred to in the afore-mentioned document), such request should be obtained from the APNR Reserve management

structures; or alternatively from the mandated regulatory provincial authorities charged with the function, namely Mpumalanga Tourism and Parks Agency (MTPA) and Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (LEDET).

- 2) SANParks did not convene a meeting to review the request, instead the relevant scientific and management teams considered the request and responded through a formal letter attached herein.
